#### **Outdoor Service with Far-Reaching Ministries**

We are excited to announce that, on **September 5th**, we are planning another outdoor service with a special speaker - Ed Amaya from **Far Reaching Ministries**. (This is the mission that Pastor Ben was scheduled to go to South Sudan with last year.) Ed oversees their missionaries in war torn countries, and he will be talking to us about Far Reaching Ministries, and the persecuted church. The outdoor service will be at the Regans' farm, starting at 10 a.m., but in case of rain, we will hold our usual 2 indoor services at the church. Registration will open as usual at 9 a.m. on the preceding Tuesday. More information about registering will be available then.

#### **Cultural Collision Conference**

On Saturday, September 11<sup>th</sup>, we will be holding an all-day, outdoor conference entitled "Cultural Collision: Equipping Christians to Navigate the Toughest Issues of the 21<sup>st</sup> Century". The conference will be held at the Regans' farm, the same location as our outdoor worship service, and we have rented a big tent for the day, so it will be going ahead rain or shine.

Join us as we explore tough questions such as the sanctity of life, gender, and God's design for the family. There will be teaching, worship, Q&A, prizes, a catered lunch, and much more! We would like everyone in the congregation to participate in this conference, including any youth in Grade 6 and up.
