The Plunge

On **Sunday, February 13th**, Pastor Benjamin and a team from Calvary Gravenhurst will take "The Plunge" into icy lake water in order to raise funds for our suffering brothers and sisters in Burkina Faso. The funds will be sent to Paradise Orphanage in Kaya, Burkina Faso to enable our brothers and sisters there to provide lifesaving food in the name of Christ to the displaced people who are moving into their area. Every \$250 raised equals one minute in the icy water for one of our volunteers, who will tag team every minute to reach the time goal. Every \$1 raised feeds a family of 4 in Burkina Faso for a day.
