This fall at Calvary we are starting **Prayer Groups** as a way to emphasize the role of prayer in our Christian walk, and to encourage each of us to foster a vibrant and healthy prayer life in our own personal and family life. Our hope for these groups is that we would widen and deepen our understanding of all of the different aspects of prayer that God has called us to in His Word.

THESE GROUPS ARE FOR EVERYONE, whether you already have a strong and vibrant prayer life, or you know very little about prayer outside of praying at meals and bedtimes, and may even feel intimidated to pray out loud.. There is a place for everyone.

In addition to prayer, we also want to use the first half hour of our nights together to **DIVE DEEPER INTO THE SERMON** from the previous Sunday. Together as a group we will practice and model what it looks like to unpack a sermon. We'll look at how to actively listen and engage with sermons. We'll practice testing what we hear against God's Word and we'll also practice applying the text to our lives. And finally we'll practice how to pray about what we have heard.

TIME COMMITMENT

These groups will meet once a month in the second week of every month from October 2022 – March 2023.

There will be groups meeting on Tuesday, Wednesday, & Thursday Nights, from 6:30 – 8:00 p.m. For more information and to register for one of these groups, please look on the website under PROGRAMS. 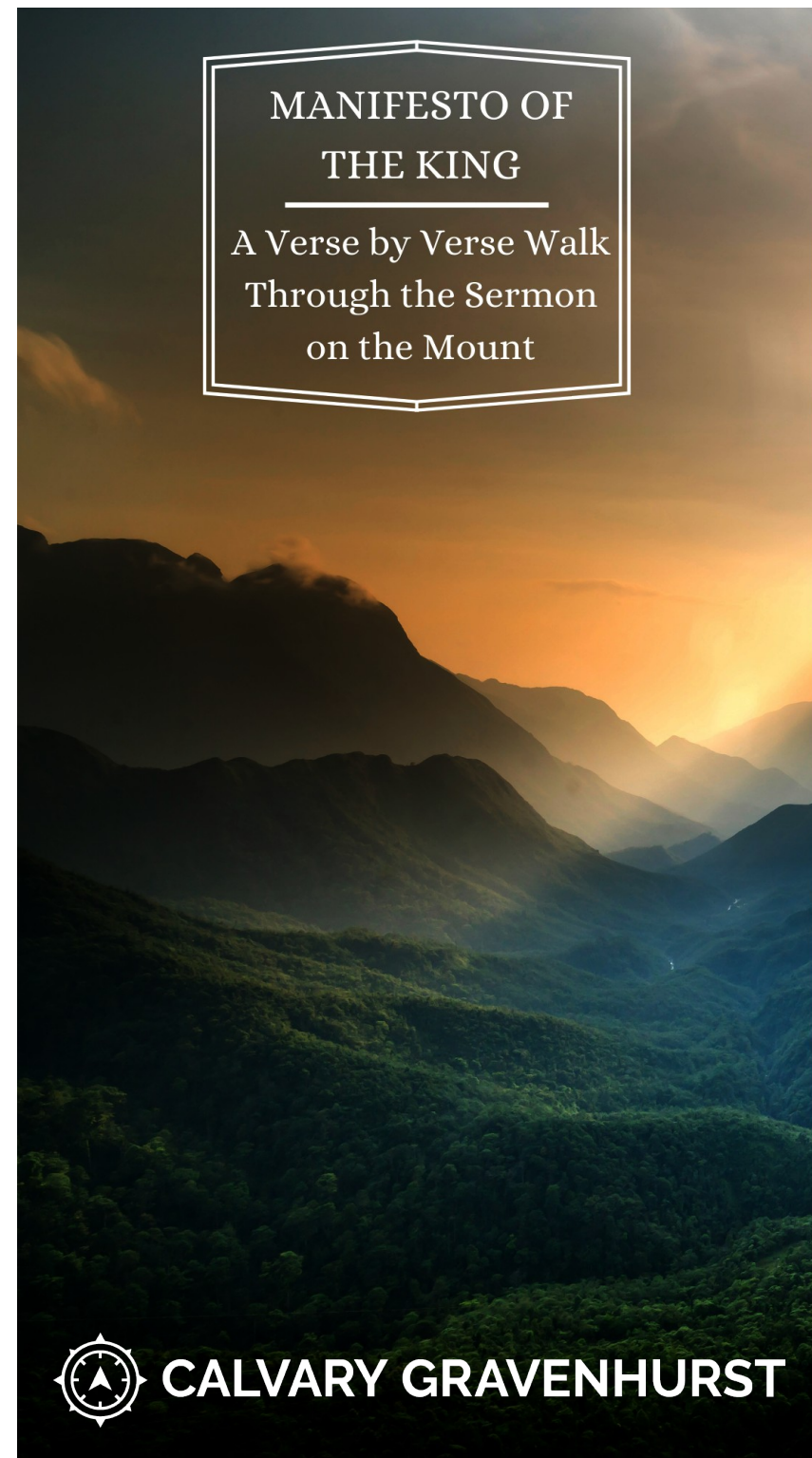
PASTOR BEN'S VACATION & SABBATICAL
