This fall at Calvary we are starting **Prayer Groups** as a way to emphasize the role of prayer in our Christian walk, and to encourage each of us to foster a vibrant and healthy prayer life in our own personal and family life. Our hope for these groups is that we would widen and deepen our understanding of all of the different aspects of prayer that God has called us to in His Word.

**THESE GROUPS ARE FOR EVERYONE,** whether you already have a strong and vibrant prayer life, or you know very little about prayer outside of praying at meals and bedtimes, and may even feel intimidated to pray out loud. There is a place for everyone.

In addition to prayer, we also want to use the first half hour of our nights together to **DIVE DEEPER INTO THE SERMON** from the previous Sunday.
